MOTION: THAT THE FOLLOWING BE ADDED TO THE BYELAWS

Article 17: Sylvia Powell Trust

Section 1: Guidelines

1. The Sylvia Powell Trust shall be "specifically for the purpose of providing aid and assistance to needy individuals, preferable but not limited to those in the Wynyard area. Such aid and assistance may be in the form of medical and mobility equipment and for the cost of medical treatment, but such decision shall be at the absolute discretion of the Rotary Club of Wynyard Inc."

Section 2: Sylvia Powell Trust Subcommittee

2. The Sylvia Powell Trust is to be administered by a subcommittee of FIVE members of the Rotary Club of Wynyard Inc.
3. The Board shall appoint the members of the Sylvia Powell Trust Subcommittee at the July Board meeting in each year.
4. The role of the subcommittee is to investigate all requests made to the Trust and to make recommendations to the Board regarding these requests.
5. Once the Board has appointed the subcommittee members, the subcommittee will elect a Convener to act as Chairman and Board liaison.
6. A Quorum is three members.
7. Minutes are to be kept of all meetings.
8. In the event of an extended absence of a member from the subcommittee, the Board can appoint a casual vacancy to cover the period of absence.

Section 3: Trust Finances

9. Money from the trust will be invested in "a special account known as the Sylvia Powell Trust"
10. The Rotary Club of Wynyard Inc can charge a fee for administering the Trust payable from the interest which will be received by the trust investment.
