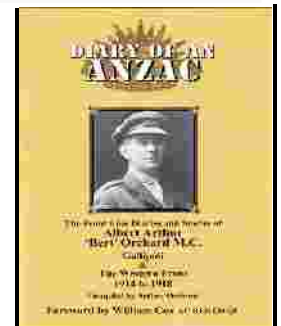


Diary of an ANZAC
