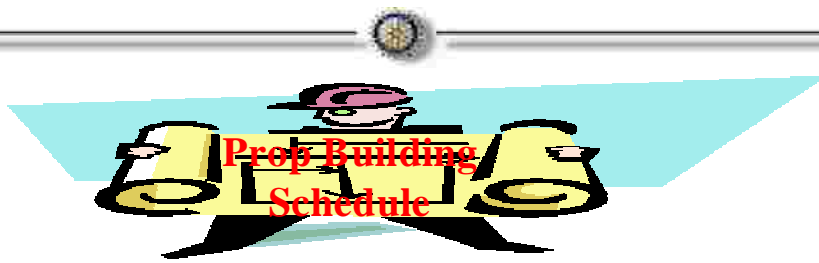

Sylvia Powell died on the 15th December 2008 and under the terms of her Will, after providing various legacies she bequeathed the residue of her estate to the Rotary Club of Wynyard Inc.

This bequest is on the basis that the club holds a special account known as the "Sylvia Powell Trust" which is intended:

"specifically for the purpose of providing aid and assistance to needy individuals, preferable but not limited to those in the Wynyard area. Such aid and assistance may be in the form of medical and mobility equipment and for the cost of medical treatment, but such decision shall be at the absolute discretion of the Rotary Club of Wynyard Inc."
